Requirements for Cancer-Center members to be eligible for 17.5% credit, rather than 15%, after qualified imaging and radiochemistry expenses exceed \$5,000 for the year:

1. Provide a short written report of their work and explain its significance to cancer research upon request (generally at the time of Cancer Center reviews and grant renewals)
2. Provide slides and other data for progress reports
3. Attend and present at Cancer Center meetings
4. Acknowledge the Cancer Center base grant and the Animal Imaging Shared Resource in any publications deriving from this work

Requirements for California National Primate Research Center member to be eligible for 17.5% credit, rather than 15%, after qualified imaging and radiochemistry expenses exceed \$5,000 for the year:

1. Provide a short written report of their work and explain its significance to the mission of the CNPRC upon request (generally at the time of base grant reviews and renewals)
2. Provide slides and other data for progress reports
3. Acknowledge the Multimodal Imaging Core and the CNPRC base grant in any publications deriving from this work
